Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Assist scene shop staff with proper construction, fabrication, installation, rigging, and strike of scenic elements for three shows built with a third-party scene shop;
- Assist with in-house build of outdoor touring TYA production;
- Provide daily maintenance and inspection of tools for safe operation;
- Assist in the upkeep, cleanup, and maintenance of work areas and equipment;
- Assist in production changeovers;
- Execute show cues and scene shift changes as necessary;
- Work with relative Department Heads to provide daily maintenance and inspection of sets, props, and other show related materials;
- Participate in pre-show and post-show related work calls;
- Execute safety protocols by wearing appropriate personal protective equipment while working in the shop, during load-ins, techs, and changeovers;
- Assist other production departments as necessary;
- Assist in loading, unloading, securing, and driving items in rented box truck;
- Attend Young Professional Career Development Meetings;
- Provide support for special events.

- Demonstrated interest in theatrical productions;
- Knowledge of shop equipment maintenance and usage;
- Proficiency in wood and metal scenic construction and fabrication techniques;
